Discretion is required when posting pictures on the Internet. Remember anything on the Internet is NEVER private and can be seen by anyone if they dig hard enough.

The following types of pictures are prohibited from being posted or used on any media outlet

- The animal is photographed through the enclosure bars
- The enclosure bars are the majority of the background
- It is obvious the animal is at your private residence (beds, kitchen, etc.)
- Crates or carriers are visible

Keep in mind that though you may have the best intentions, your images can be taken out of context. If you feel a group may be able to take the picture and use it negatively against the Center, do not post it.

If there are pictures that you aren't sure about you may email them to management at info@wildlifelearningcenter.com. They will respond promptly with a decision. I acknowledge that any pictures on any media must be taken down immediately if instructed to do so by Wildlife Learning Center management.
